

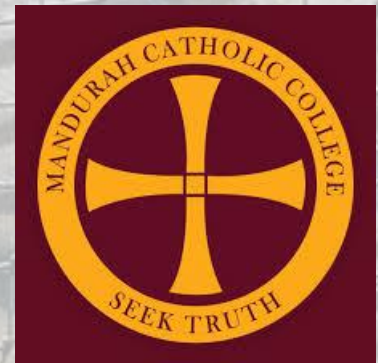

## **BUS DROP OFF | PARKING | ACCESS**

- Buses are advised to enter via Wembley Court into the main carpark, with this also being the closest point to the main entrance and ramp access into the venue (per site map)

## **ARRIVAL**

- Please **arrive by 9:30am**, to allow time to organise students
- Please ensure you 'check in' on arrival, so we are aware you are on site
- Please collect **wristbands for those students who DO NOT have photo permissions** from the ACC

## **FOOD AND WATER**

- Lord's Café will be open for the duration of the event
- Water fountains are marked on the enclosed map

## **FIRST AID**

For any athlete taken to the First Aid Post they must be supervised by a staff member

## **VENUE FACILITIES**

- Toilet facilities will be utilised by both staff and students and location detailed on the map provided.
- The centres squash walkway has been booked for the duration of the event, for schools to use during their break periods. This area IS NOT to be used as a recreational space, but purely for staff and students to utilise while eating and must be left the way in which it is found, to avoid incurring any cleaning charges.
- All courts are accessible and suitable for wheelchair use

## **PRE-GAME ACTIVITIES**

- We will commence the day with a soccer skill session, which is being delivered by the amazing staff of the Stephen Michael Foundation, and Maddi Hewson is the Event Carnival Manager (details provided within)
- Please note that Trent Sharpe (Sport Operations Manager, ACC) will be on site pre-carnival to support SMF and the schools attending, and will return prior to carnival presentations
- SMF staff will co-ordinate the delivery of a skills session, for all teams, prior to the fixtured games commencing.

## **FIXTURES**

- Round robin fixtures will commence after the pre-game activities, per the event day summary
- SMF staff will umpire / mentor all games  
**PLEASE NOTE : schools may need to support with umpiring on the day, so please ensure your peer support student and or teachers are equipped with a whistle(s) to do so if required**
- Schools are to support scoring every game, with results to be signed off by each time before umpires return to the ACC area
- There are two pools (Tottenham and West Ham), with cross pool finals played after the fixtured rounds
- The venue's central timing system will be utilised for the duration of the carnival
- Fixtures will be on display, with copies also made available for all schools

- PLEASE ensure you are across the event timings, and you are aware :
  - \* of the court number you are playing on
  - \* what time / round your team has a bye
  - \* that Court 5 is being utilised from Round 3 onwards

#### **EQUIPMENT**

- Football boots and shin guards are **NOT** to be worn on the day of the carnival
- Mouthguards are optional, but definitely not a necessity
- All balls, cones and goals will be provided (and set up) by the ACC and supporting partners
- Schools are encouraged to bring their own playing bibs, which are to be worn should school sport uniforms clash
- All peer support students on ground, are to wear a high visual vest, and if not available from your school, please collect one from the ACC

#### **CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION & SHIELD WINNERS**

- These will be provided to each school, during the end of day presentations. Please have a student in mind and ready to collect on behalf of your school.
- The grand final winner will be presented the Ainslie Waddell Shield

# GAME RULES

- Games are played on established and marked futsal courts, at Lord's Recreation Centre
- Games will run for 15 minutes, with NO half time break
- There is a 5 minute change over time allocated between fixtured round games
- 6 players per team on the court at one time, which includes the goalkeeper
- A maximum of 2 peer support students are allowed on the court at any one time
- Games commence with a kick off from the centre of the court. The decision of which team commences the game is determined by paper, scissor, rock challenge between the two captains
- During play, once the goalkeeper has gained possession of the ball, he/she may either kick or throw the ball into play
- Indoor soccer is essentially a non-contact sport. Some minor touching where neither player involved gains an advantage may be allowed. If illegal contact occurs, a placed free kick is awarded to the disadvantaged team. Free kicks will also be awarded if a player other than a goalkeeper, handles the ball, except students in chairs, and students/staff supporting them
- Goals may be scored only from the offensive half of the court. Goals scored from the defensive half of the court will be disallowed, and a free kick awarded on the halfway line
- For free kicks, goal kicks and restarts, defenders must be a minimum of 2 metres from the ball
- All players, apart from the goalkeeper, are required to play both defence and attack
- A ball that goes over a sideline that is next to a wall or net, within 1 metre is played on
- A ball hitting a wheelchair is considered to be in that person's possession and is placed in the player's lap, to be pushed out and into play

## PEER SUPPORT STUDENTS

- Peer support students are to **play alongside students**, supporting their skills and game, and to **pass the ball, to facilitate maximum participation** from all. They are to **provide mentoring and on-field coaching**, creating maximum participation and **NOT lead the direction of play**.
- Peer support students must also be rotated in positions, to ensure that participants are provided the opportunity to play in numerous positions across the course of the carnival.
- Peer support students are NOT to score, and if they do, the result will not be recorded, with the opposition receiving a free kick out of goals.
- Peer support students on ground, must wear a high vis VEST at all times if on the court

## GAMES POINT SCORING

- WIN = 3 points
- DRAW = 2 points
- LOSS = 1 point

## FINALS

- Overall game points determine the ladder and subsequent finals fixtures. Should not all teams within a pool have a BYE, final ladder placings are determined through goal differential.
- If a GRAND FINAL result is a draw, the team with the highest goal differential after fixtured rounds, will determine the overall winner

**NOTE : finals fixtures will be announced prior to the conclusion of lunch**
