BBQ LUNCH (Sorrento Surf Club Courtyard)

BUS DROP AND COLLECTION POINT

Buses enter as detailed on enclosed map, and are requested to make their way out of this area PROMPTLY once students have been dropped off

MARQUEES

There are two permanent shade sails on site, however schools are advised to bring sufficient shade and ground cover for the day for students and staff, and set up per the site map. HOST SCHOOL volunteers will be available to assist with the transport of marquees from the buses to the beach

CHANGING PLACE & TOILETS

- Toilets are situated as part of the Sorrento Beach Surf Lifesaving Club building, and there is an additional block to the north of this building
- The Changing Place is part of the building north of the surf club, however you will need to see ACC staff for key access to these facilities

BEACH WHEELCHAIRS

- There is one (1) beach wheelchair available, within the onsite storage unit.
- Please see ACC staff for access.

WATER FOUNTAIN

Water fountains are marked on the site map within the event program

FIRST AID

For any student taken to the First Aid Post, they must be supervised by a teacher / parent support.

STAFF SUPERVISION

- Schools are to ensure there is always sufficient teacher supervision for your students
- School staff are to remain with their students for the duration of all activities.
- Surf Rescue Supervisors are responsible for water safety of all participants across the entire event, and CAN NOT be responsible for the supervision of their own school students at any point in time

SURF RESCUE SUPERVISORS & ALLOCATED HOST STUDENT ASSISTANTS

You will be in the water for the duration of the Ironman Events, as well as providing support for all water-based activities, during the rotations. It is strongly recommended, you wear suitable attire to keep you warm in the water during this time.

Two Surf Lifesaving WA staff will be on site for the duration of the event, stationed at either end of the course during the Iron Man events, and stationed accordingly during the activity rotations.

EQUIPMENT

- Schools are responsible to bring equipment required to deliver assigned activity
- Please ensure you have enough equipment to accommodate the group sizes
- If you have any boogie boards, please bring these with you for the Ironman events and ensure they are clearly labelled

ACTIVITY ROTATIONS

- Schools are responsible for the delivery of their allocated activity, and the required number of staff **MUST REMAIN** on the activity for the duration of the rotations
- Surf Rescue Supervisors (SRS) have been allocated to an area during the activities, with a larger number allocated to the support of body boarding. SRS **MUST** remain on the allocated activity, and will be unable to support supervision of school students
- Schools to set up activities in allocated locations, **during the morning tea break**
- Students have been placed into social participation groups, and all schools will be provided a list of their students and their groups on arrival
- Groups 1 – 4 rotate through the SURFIES area (as mapped)
- Groups 5 – 8 rotate through the SANDGROPERs area (as mapped)
- Students to gather after morning tea at their numbered group sign
- HOST student assistants will accompany groups in support of activities
- Schools who have school assistants attending, can assign their students to groups as they see fit
- Rotations are provided within, and will displayed on the reverse side of each activity station sign
- Sessions will run for 15 minutes, with a 5 minute transition period between each
- A siren / horn will signal the end of each session, with groups then moving to their next activity, per the rotation provided
- **NOTE** the activities do vary between the 'Surfies' and 'Sandgroper's' groups, so students will not experience all activities on offer on the day

BBQ LUNCH

Thankyou so very much to the wonderful volunteers from Sacred Heart College, who will be preparing the BBQ. This will be at Sorrento Life Saving Club after the conclusion of the day, where all students, staff and volunteers will be provided a hot dog, and a juice box will be available for all students.

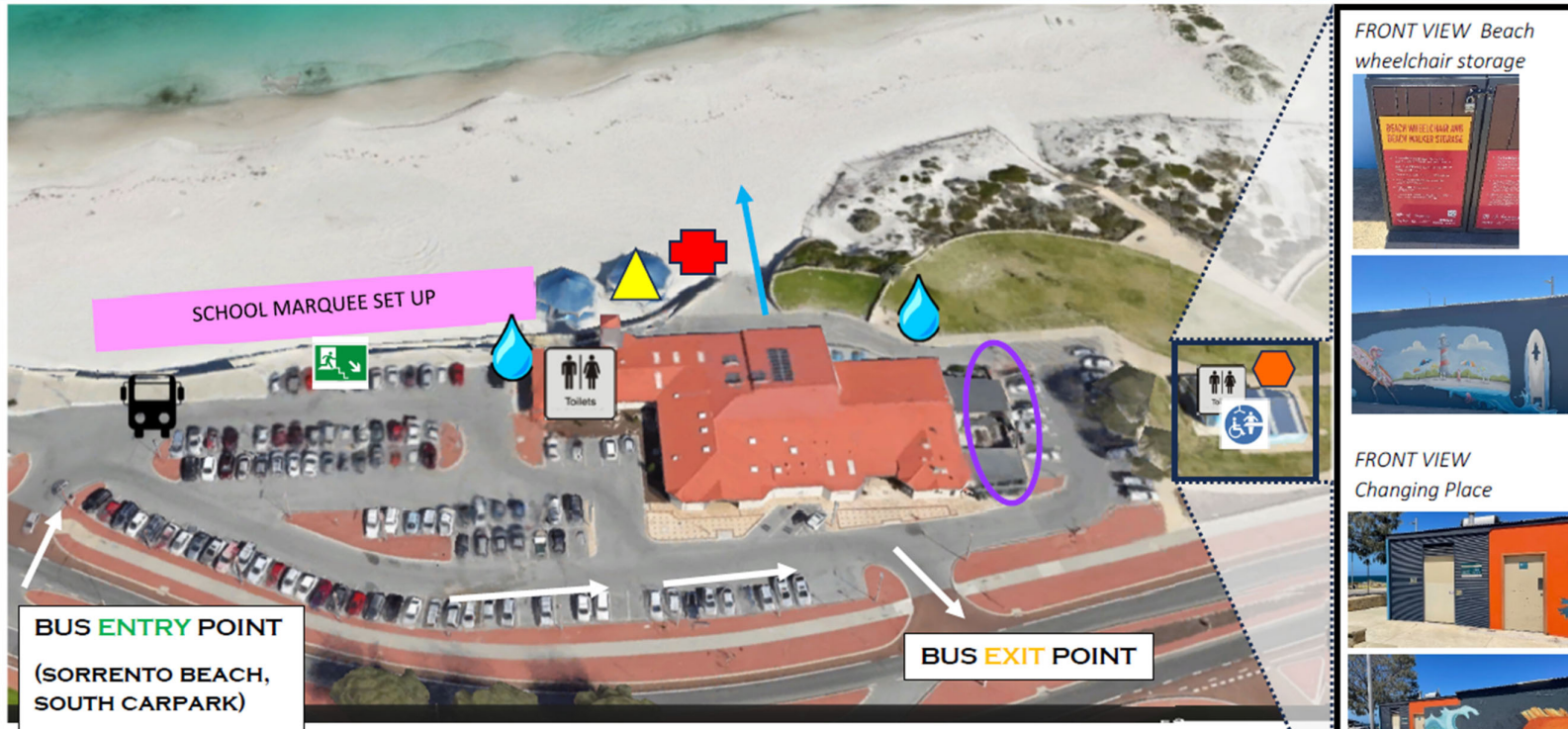

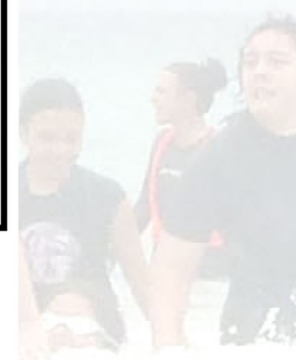

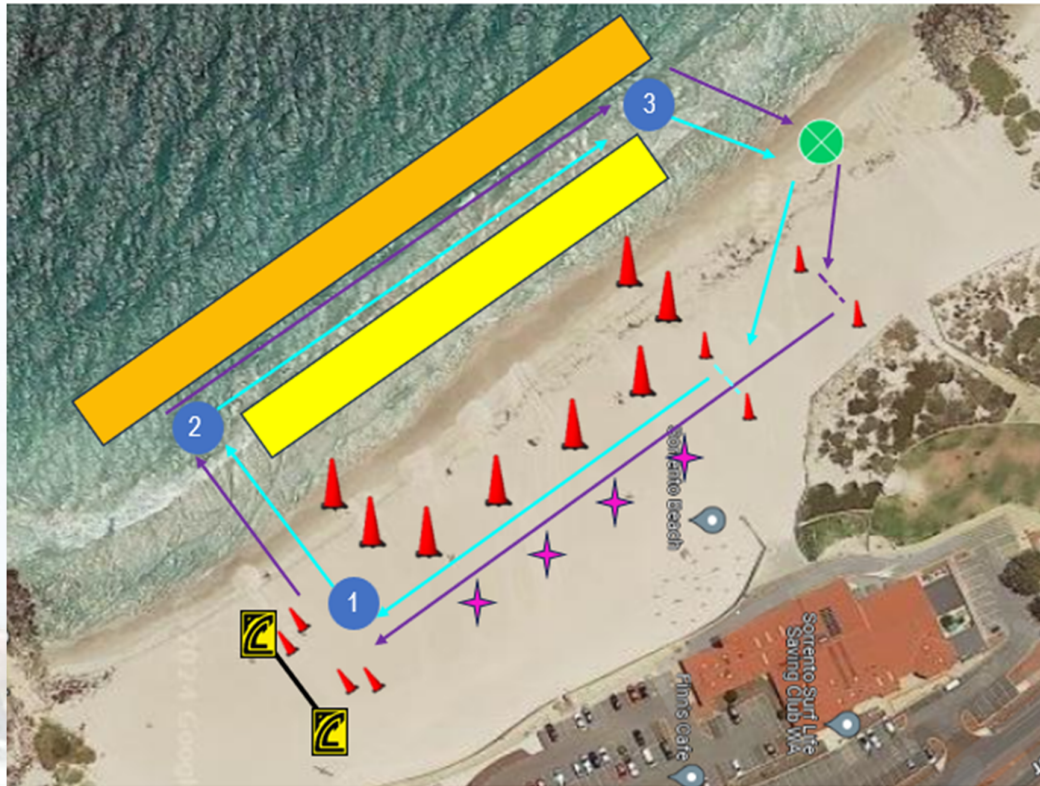

10:05am	<p>ENTICER EVENTS EVENT 1 BOYS EVENT 2 GIRLS</p> <p>For those students who would like to participate in a shorter, standing depth event</p> <p>PURSUIT EVENTS EVENT 3 BOYS EVENT 4 GIRLS</p> <p>For those students who would like the challenge of a longer course in deeper water NOTE : students who participate in the ENTICER event ARE NOT to participate in the PURSUIT event also</p>












IRONMAN EVENT INFORMATION

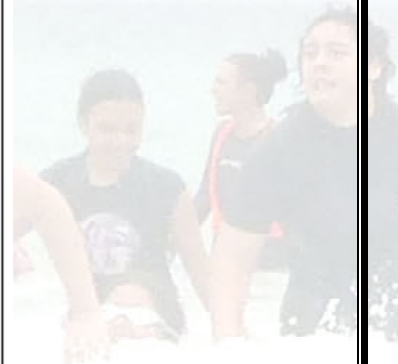
1.	Participants line up on the relevant event starting line (per site map)
2.	On the sound of the starting horn, participants run along the beach, to the end of the bunting (runs length of the beach) TURN POINT 1
3.	Participants turn towards the water, towards channel formed by the line of Surf Rescue Supervisors (ORANGE vests) and student water safety assistants (YELLOW vests) TURN POINT 2
4.	Participants then swim / wade through the water, between the channel of Surf Rescue Supervisors and student water safety assistants to the last student water safety volunteer TURN POINT 3
5.	Participants run / wade back to the shore, and COLLECT a boogie board
6.	Participants run in a straight line along the beach with the boogie board, until they reach the end of the bunting TURN POINT 1
7.	Participants turn towards the water, and make their way to the SRS and student water safety volunteers TURN POINT 2
8.	Participants paddle with the boogie board, between the channel of SRS and student water safety volunteers until TURN POINT 3
9.	Participants make their way back to shore, and RETURN the boogie board to the COLLECTION / RETURN POINT
10.	Participants make their way to the finish line marked by the two ACC flags
