## EVENT DAY SCHEDULE

Before 8:45am	Host School Onsite
Before 9:30am	All Schools Onsite
9:45am	CARNIVAL WELCOME LEAD SRS : briefing to SRS and student water safety assistants
9:50am	Ironman competitors to move towards start line
10:05am	Ironman events
10:35am	MORNING TEA <i>** Schools to set up their activity during this time **</i>
10:55am	Students into pre-determined groups, behind numbered signs
11am – 12:15pm	Activities commence
12:15pm	Pack up
12:30pm	BBQ LUNCH (Sorrento Surf Club Courtyard)

## BUS DROP AND COLLECTION POINT

Buses to follow route per enclosed map, and are to PROMPTLY move out of this area once students have been dropped off

## ARRIVAL

- 'Check in' on arrival
- **Wristband** collection for those who **DO NOT have photo permissions**
- Vest collection Surf Rescue Supervisor (ORANGE) Student volunteers (YELLOW)

## MARQUEES

Two permanent shade sails are on site, however schools are advised to bring sufficient shade and ground cover for the day, and set up per the site map. HOST SCHOOL volunteers will be available to assist with the transport of marquees from the buses to the beach.

## CHANGING PLACE & TOILETS

- Toilets are situated as part of the Sorrento Beach Surf Lifesaving Club building, and there is an additional block to the north of this building
- The Changing Place is part of the building north of the surf club, however you will need to see ACC staff for key access to these facilities

**NOTE : the facilities DO NOT have a sling – please confirm your sling's compatibility with the hoist provided by contacting the City of Joondalup directly.**

## BEACH WHEELCHAIRS

- There is one (1) beach wheelchair available, within the onsite storage unit.
- Please see ACC staff for access.

## EQUIPMENT

- Schools are responsible to bring all equipment required to deliver assigned activity
- Please ensure you have enough equipment to accommodate the group sizes (approximately 20 in each group)
- If you have a student(s) keen to participate in the Iron Man event(s), please bring a body board with you for each student, and ensure they are clearly labelled

## FIRST AID

For any student taken to the First Aid Post, they must be supervised by a teacher / parent support.

## STAFF SUPERVISION

- Schools are to ensure there is always sufficient teacher supervision for your students
- School staff are to remain with their students for the duration of all activities.
- Surf Rescue Supervisors are responsible for water safety of all participants across the entire event, and CAN NOT be responsible for the supervision of their own school students at any point in time

## SURF RESCUE SUPERVISORS & ALLOCATED HOST STUDENT ASSISTANTS

- You will be in the water for the duration of the Ironman Events, as well as providing support for all water-based activities, during the rotations.
- It is strongly recommended, you wear suitable attire to keep you warm in the water during this time.

Two Surf Lifesaving WA staff will be on site for the duration of the event, stationed at either end of the course during the Iron Man events, and positioned accordingly during the activity rotations.

## ACTIVITY ROTATIONS

- Schools are responsible for the delivery of their allocated activity, and the required number of staff **MUST REMAIN** on the activity for the duration of the rotations

- Schools to set up activities in allocated locations, **during the morning tea break**
- Students are in social participation groups, with this information available from the ACC on arrival
  - Groups 1 – 4 rotate through the *SURFIES* area
  - Groups 5 – 9 rotate through the *SANDGROPER*s area
- Staff to organise students behind their numbered sign AFTER morning tea
- HOST student assistants will accompany groups in support of activities
- Schools who have school assistants attending, can assign their students to groups as they see fit
- Rotations are detailed within the program, and will be displayed on the reverse each activity sign
- Sessions will run for 15 minutes, with a 5 minute transition period between each
- A siren / horn will signal the end of each session, with groups then moving to their next activity, per the rotation provided
- **NOTE** the activities do vary between the *SURFIES* and *SANDGROPER*s groups, so students will not experience all activities available on the day
- Surf Rescue Supervisors (SRS) have been allocated to an area during the activities, with a larger number allocated to the support of body boarding.
- SRS **MUST** remain on the allocated activity, and will be unable to support supervision of their school students

## CAFÉ & BBQ LUNCH

Sorrento Beach Café is open for the duration of the event.

Thank you to the wonderful volunteers from Sacred Heart College, who will prepare the BBQ. This will be at Sorrento Life Saving Club after the conclusion of the day, where all students, staff and volunteers will be provided a hot dog, and a juice box.

## WATER FOUNTAIN

Water fountains are marked on the site map within the event program

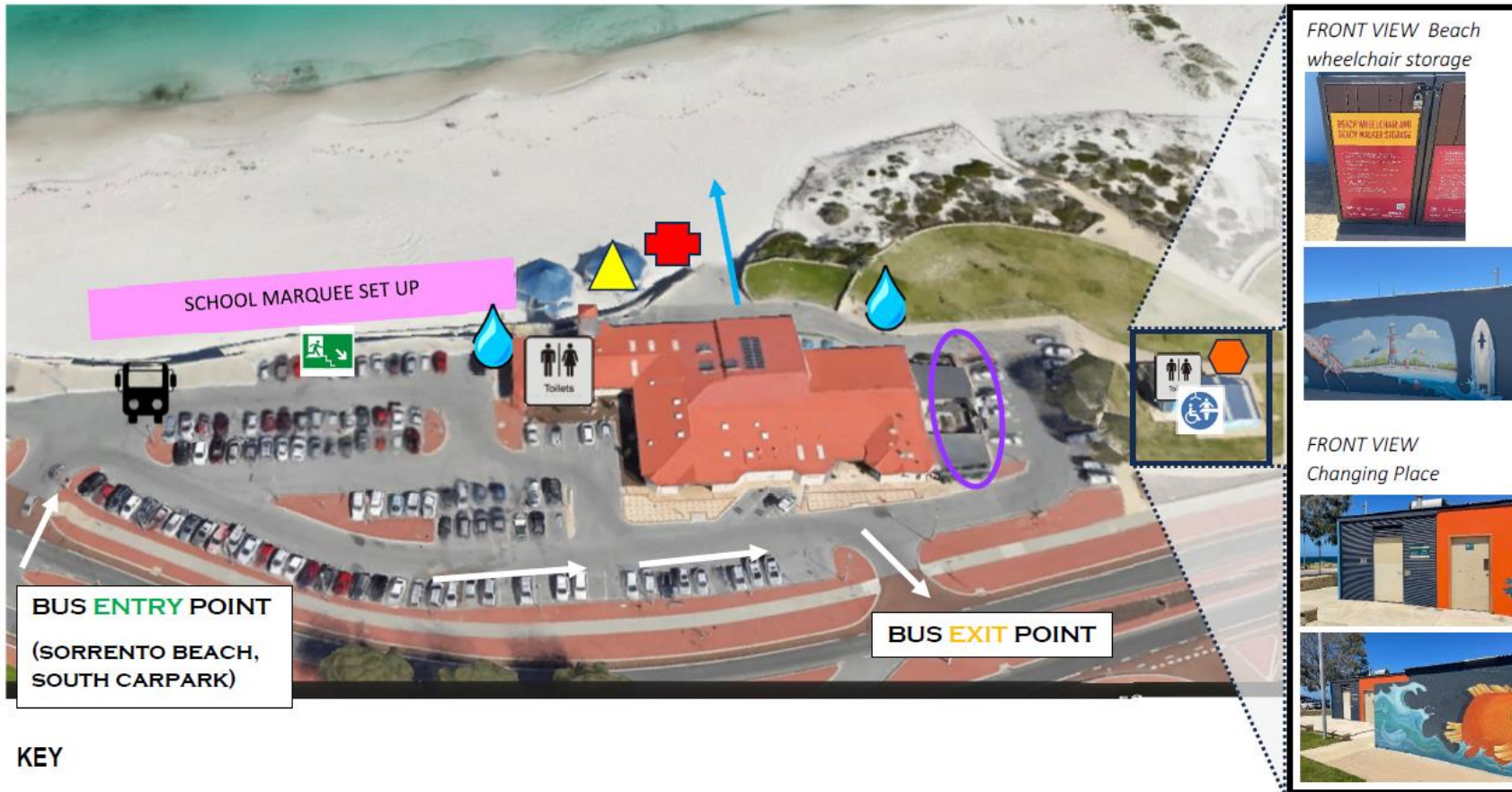

# BEACH CARNIVAL SET UP (SORRENTO BEACH, CENTRAL)



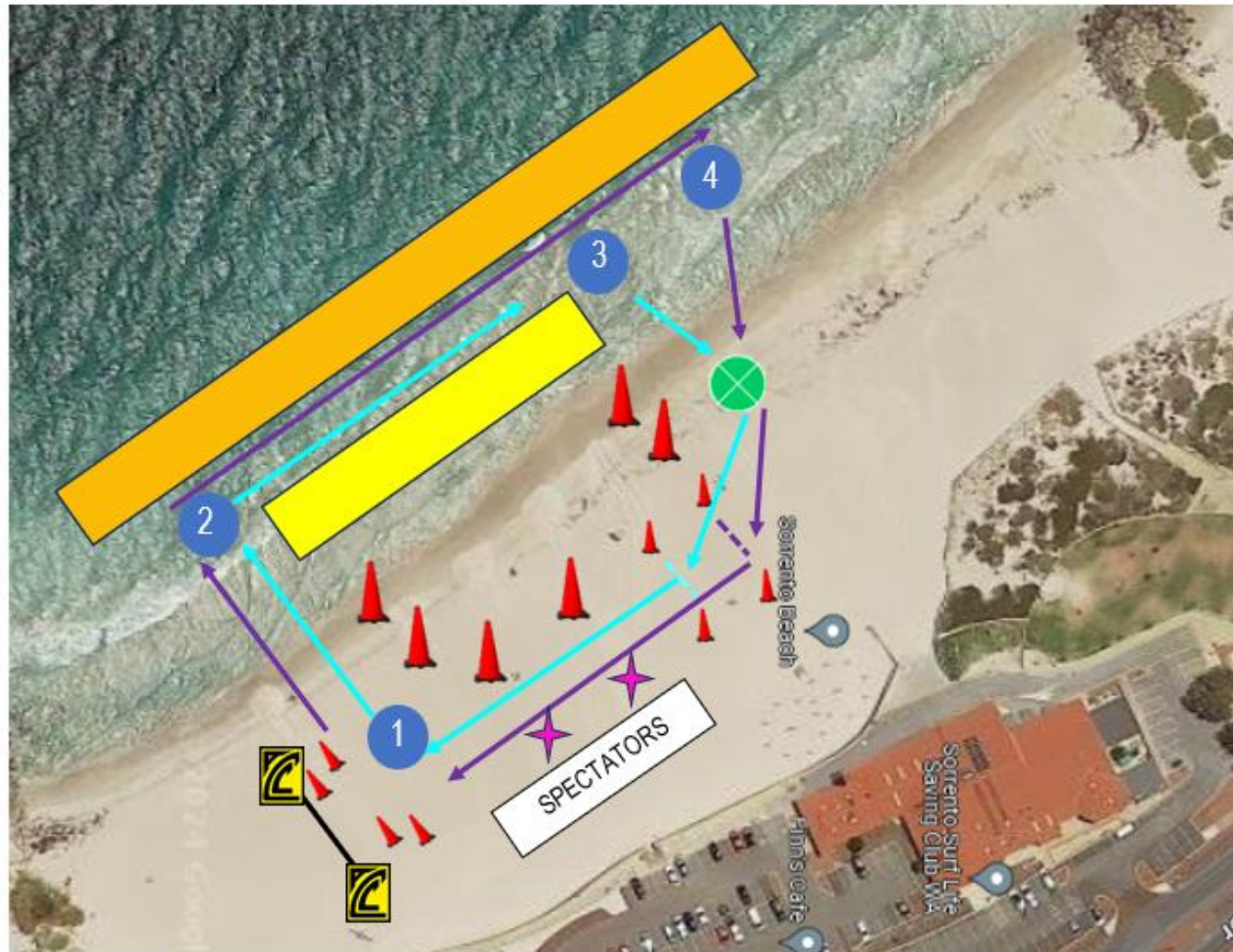

## IRONMAN EVENTS

TIME	DETAILS
10:05am	<p>EVENT 1   BOYS ENTICER EVENT 2   GIRLS ENTICER</p> <p>For students who would like to participate in a shorter, standing depth event</p> <p>EVENT 3   BOYS PURSUIT EVENT 4   GIRLS PURSUIT</p> <p>For students who would like the challenge of a longer course in deeper water <i>NOTE : students can ONLY compete in one event, NOT BOTH</i></p>
IRONMAN EVENT INFORMATION	
1.	Participants line up on the relevant event starting line (per site map)
2.	On the sound of the starting horn, participants run along the beach, to the end of the bunting (runs length of the beach) <b>TURN POINT 1</b>
3.	Participants turn towards the water, towards channel formed by the line of Surf Rescue Supervisors (ORANGE vests) and student water safety assistants (YELLOW vests) <b>TURN POINT 2</b>
4.	Participants then swim / wade through the water, between the channel of Surf Rescue Supervisors and student water safety assistants to the last student water safety volunteer <b>TURN POINT 3</b>
5.	Participants run / wade back to the shore, and COLLECT a body board
6.	Participants run in a straight line along the beach with the body board, until they reach the end of the bunting <b>TURN POINT 1</b>
7.	Participants turn towards the water, and make their way to the SRS and student water safety volunteers <b>TURN POINT 2</b>
8.	Participants paddle with the body board, between the channel of SRS and student water safety volunteers until <b>TURN POINT 3</b>
9.	Participants make their way back to shore, and RETURN the body board to the COLLECTION / RETURN POINT
10.	Participants make their way to the finish line marked by the two ACC flags <i>NOTE : Place medallions and participation ribbons are presented at the finish line, immediately after each event.</i>
