BUS DROP AND COLLECTION POINT

Buses can drop staff and students along Jackadder Way. Rosewood Avenue is a single lane in both directions, and **does not allow** for buses to stop and or park.

ARRIVAL

- 'Check in' on arrival with ACC Carnival Manager
- **Wristband** collection for those who **do not** have photo permissions

MARQUEES

Spuds Marquees will provide and erect two large marquees. These **will not** be adequate for all schools in attendance. Please bring sufficient shade / ground over for the event and set up per the provided site map. The permanent shelter **is not a** bookable space and therefore is a first come first served basis.

COURSE MARSHALS AND VOLUNTEERS

- Course Marshals to be on site **no later than 9:30am** and sign in with ACC Carnival Manager on arrival (*ACC tent*)
- There will be a briefing conducted **at 9:45am**, you will be provided an ACC official vest, and requested to then move to your designated station on the course
- Ensure you have your mobile phone with you, as you will be provided the ACC Carnival Manager's number to save to your phone.
- Student peer volunteers, are requested to collect a **yellow** ACC officials vest from the ACC tent

- The final teacher / support staff completing the Fun Run, will inform Course Station officials they are the last person of the event. Course Marshals to collect numbered stake and return to ACC tent

VENUE FACILITIES

- Path access around the entire lake and up to, and around the toilet block
- Public toilet facilities
 - Male toilets including an ambulant
 - Female toilets x2, plus ambulant
 - Unisex accessible toilet
- Coffee van will be on site for the duration of the venue
- Water fountains marked on enclosed map
- Thankyou to Lumen Christi College, all attendees will enjoy a sausage sizzle, which for students includes a juice box
- Being a community space, staff are to support students completing the Fun Run, being mindful of public using the footpaths. Students utilising the playground **must be** supervised by a staff member, at all times.

FIRST AID

Students taken to the First Aid Post, must be supervised by a teacher / parent support.

WEATHER

A reminder to ensure students and staff have suitable, warm clothing for the day. Should the weather be deemed not safe for the event to go ahead, the ACC will advise schools by 8am the morning of the event, if not prior. If there is forecast of showers and wind, the event will go ahead.

EVENT FORMAT

- Fun Run is two laps of the lake along the path, and on direction of Course Station officials
- Activity rotations will commence after the recess break – please ensure all attending staff are aware of which groups your students have been allocated, for prompt organisation prior to their commencement.
 - Schools **must bring all equipment** required for the delivery of your activity, and ensure it will accommodate the varying group sizes
 - Sufficient staff **must remain on your allocated activity** for all rotations, delivering each session

CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION & SHIELD WINNER

- Medallions are awarded to the first 3 placegetters, for both Boys and Girls. All schools will be competing for the Sue Bigelow Shield (won by La Salle College in 2025)
- Certificates of participation will be presented to each school, during the end of day presentations. Please have a student in mind and ready to collect these, on behalf of your school.

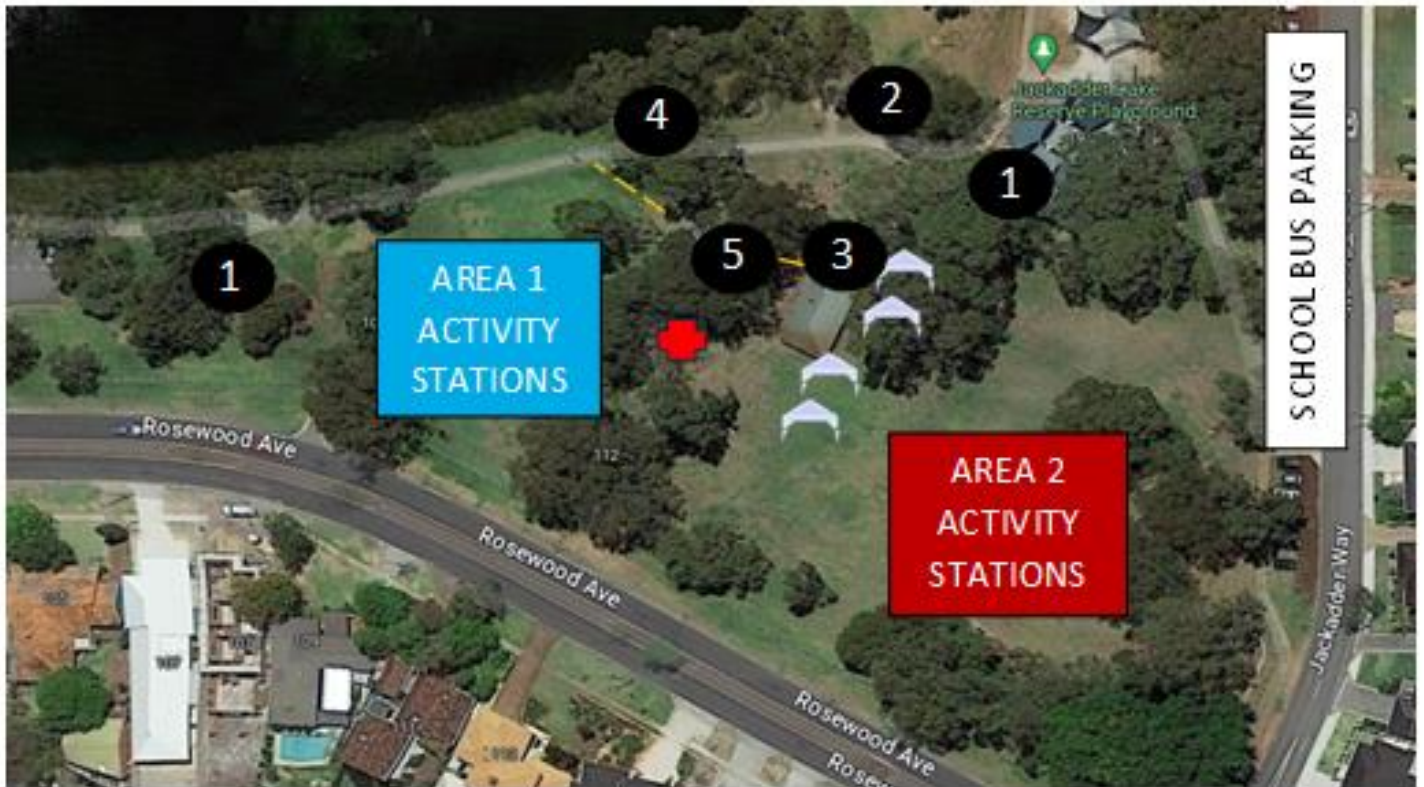
