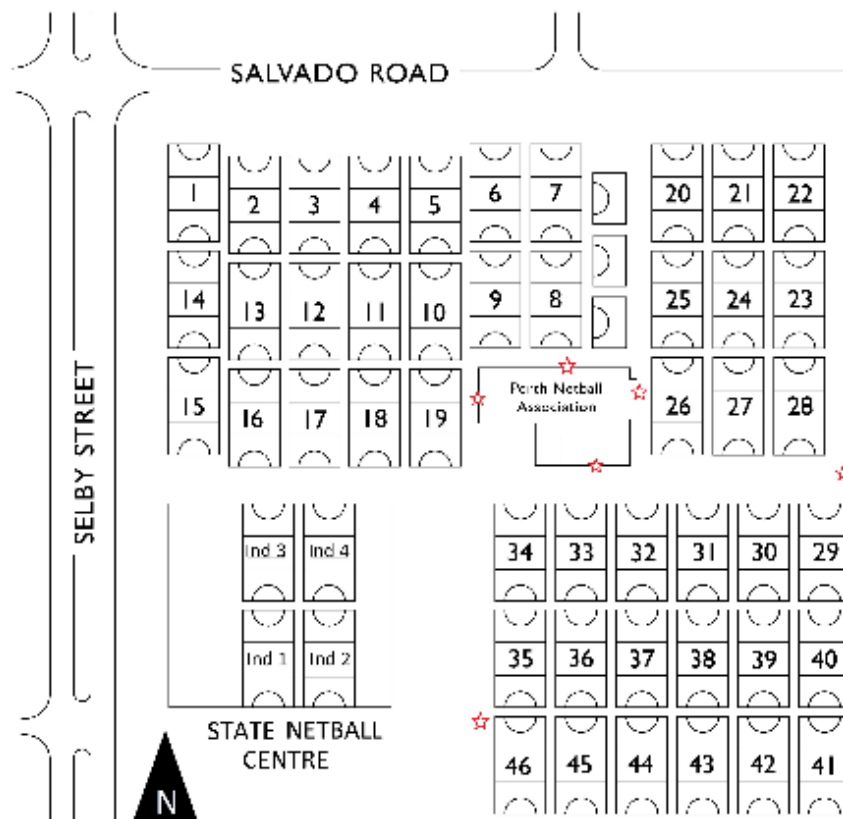

Rolling Substitution

- Rolling substitutions are permitted, whereby an on-court player can substitute with an off-court player during the game.
- There is no stoppage, and the substitution must be immediate.
- No substitutions can be made in the final 5 minutes of the game.

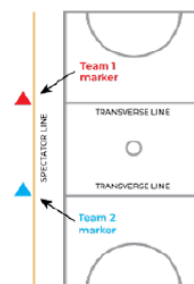
PREMATCH SETUP

Each team will have its own substitution area on the same side of the court as the scorer and timer.

Prior to the match starting, teams place a cone or marker in line with one of the transverse lines, just behind the yellow spectator line.

The umpires should confirm the substitution area with each team before the match commences.

The marker for each team stays the same for the duration of the game.



PROCEDURE FOR ROLLING SUBS

A rolling sub can take place at any time during play.

The player about to 'roll on' must stand beside their team marker.

The player 'rolling off' MUST tag hands with the player waiting to go on at the team marker. A bib swap may also need to occur here.



Player rolling on must wait within 1 step of their marker.

The 'roll on' player may now enter the court observing the offside rule i.e. move around the outside of the court before entering an onside area correct to their playing position.

A player rolling off or on the court during a Rolling sub, must observe the Offside rule. The Rolling sub must also not interfere with the movement of the umpires.

Associated and Catholic Colleges (ACC) and Netball WA reserve the right to cancel, change or amend any or all parts of this format leading up to and on the day including playing times and the fixtures. The ACC endeavours to uphold the Associations Motto of 'Sport in the Right Spirit' in all stages of planning and running of this competition.

2026 SET UP SCHOOLS: St George's AGS & Newman College (arrive 9.00am)

Venue: Gold Netball Centre & Perth Netball Association

(Set up/pack down requires goal post padding in place – all courts)

MORNING BRIEFING - COACH, CAPTAIN, SCORER & UMPIRES

Will occur approximately 25 minutes (9.05am) prior to Round 1 in a central location (court 1 or outside verandah)

A secondary briefing will occur for pools beginning at 10.10am (briefing approximately 9.50am).

DURATION & TIMING

- Carnival schedule will operate between 9:30am and 2:30pm.
- All fixtures will be running on central timing (all courts).
- All games will be two (2) x thirteen (13) minute halves / 3 minute half time / 11 minute changeover between rounds.
- All rounds will start on time; imperative that coaches have their teams briefed and be on the correct court with players in position ready to go before the starting siren/horn.
- Round 1 games must start prior to half time. If a team arriving late (at half time or after half time), the fixture will be forfeited, however both teams can play a "friendly" (no game result) in the 2nd half.

UMPIRES

Accredited netball umpires will be sourced by the ACC. Each school will be invoiced post carnival for this shared umpire cost.

SCORERS

Each team is to provide one (1) competent scorer (senior student or adult). Scorers must have a pen. The two scorers for each match, one from each competing team, are to sit/stand together court side.

SCORECARDS

Scorecards to be signed by the umpires at the completion of each fixture. It is assumed that scoring discrepancies are settled immediately at the conclusion of the game and that all results handed in to the ACC Carnival Manager are final.

SQUAD / TEAM PLAYING NUMBERS

Senior Championship Netball Teams: **Maximum Squad Size up to a 12 players with 7 on court (5 substitute players) permitted.**

INTERCHANGE / SUBSTITUTION

Rolling substitution permitted (please see page 14, Rolling Substitution), provided they are executed correctly. Substitution rules apply to the philosophy of participation and not to be used for time wasting.

EVENT RULES

Rules are in accordance with World Netball Rules as per the latest edition, 1st January 2024 unless otherwise stated, with the exception of the Tactical Changes rule. At the completion of games each team captain will call their team to give three cheers to the opposition team.

LADDER AND POINTS

Ladder: 4 points for a win, 1 point for a loss. 4 points for forfeit win, 0 points for a forfeit (25-0 score).

Should two, or more, teams achieve the same total ladder points at the end of the round robin games the finishing position will be determined by:

- Firstly, determined by points differential (points for / points against differential)
- The second differential measure will be the head-to-head game result between the tied teams. Teams cannot have a "DRAW" as per below item.
- If three (3) teams are still tied after this point the highest scoring offensive team (total points for) will decide the final order (placing).

MAXIMUM MARGIN – 25 Goals (capped result).

This is an enactment to the “mercy rule” where the **maximum margin recorded in the game will be capped at 25 goals**. At this point, scoring will stop (official match result). This ensures that teams can then rotate players to ensure all players get more game time when the maximum margin has been met and final score recorded.

NO DRAWS/EXTRA TIME

In the scenario of a draw, the team in possession at the conclusion of the game time will receive a sideline pass (restart) and the game must continue until the next goal is scored i.e. to break the deadlock. Adequate time for this exists within the fixture breaks prior to the next round getting started (11 minutes). Team scorers standing courtside must ensure they communicate clearly and loudly to the umpires and players if the scores are tied when the time is completed. This allows the umpires to award the sideline pass (restart) and continue until the next goal is scored.

WARM UP & GAME BALLS

Teams should arrive 30 minutes prior and warm up on their allocated Round 1 court. Teams must bring their own warm up and game balls. **Each team is to supply a quality match netball – size 5.**

TEAM STAFFING

Each team must be supervised by a suitable experienced adult/teacher assigned in a coaching or manager role. Schools must understand their “Duty of Care” and ensure the presence of staff at the venue (as applicable).

UNIFORMS

For all Championship games, players dress standards must be consistent with, and in line with the usual expectations for that sport and be the official team uniform for that school. **Teams must be dressed correctly and to a high representative standard.** Coded playing tops/bibs/position patches **MUST** be worn, and all teams must have a set of netball bibs or position patches in an alternative colour, for use in the case of matches with teams of similar uniform colour. Tracksuits are **NOT** acceptable items to be worn during games. No jewellery can be worn.

MOUTHGUARDS

Mouth guards are strongly recommended by the ACC for all players. Schools allowing players to play without mouth guards must take full responsibility for any injuries incurred.

TOILETS/CHANGEROOMS

Are only to be used for toilet facilities or access to water; they are not to be used to congregate or have team meetings.

DRINKS / FOOD

Responsibility of each team. Drink fountains are available at the venue. Should school drink containers require refilling, there are taps available at various locations. Gold Netball Centre has a kiosk that may also be open for light refreshments.

FIRST AID

St John Ambulance will be available at the venue (organised and booked by the ACC).

POST CARNIVAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Acknowledgements will commence immediately following the final round of fixtures. All players, coaches and umpires are invited to move to the designated point (TBC) for acknowledgement asap after the final game.

QUALIFICATION SEMI FINALS

ACC Championship Qualification Semi Finals will be played on the Qualification carnival day where time or fixturing permits. In some instances, Semi Final games may be required to be played at a later date (in coming weeks) between two teams to ensure that the North or South Qualification team progresses into the Grand Final as planned.

QUALIFICATION GRAND FINALS

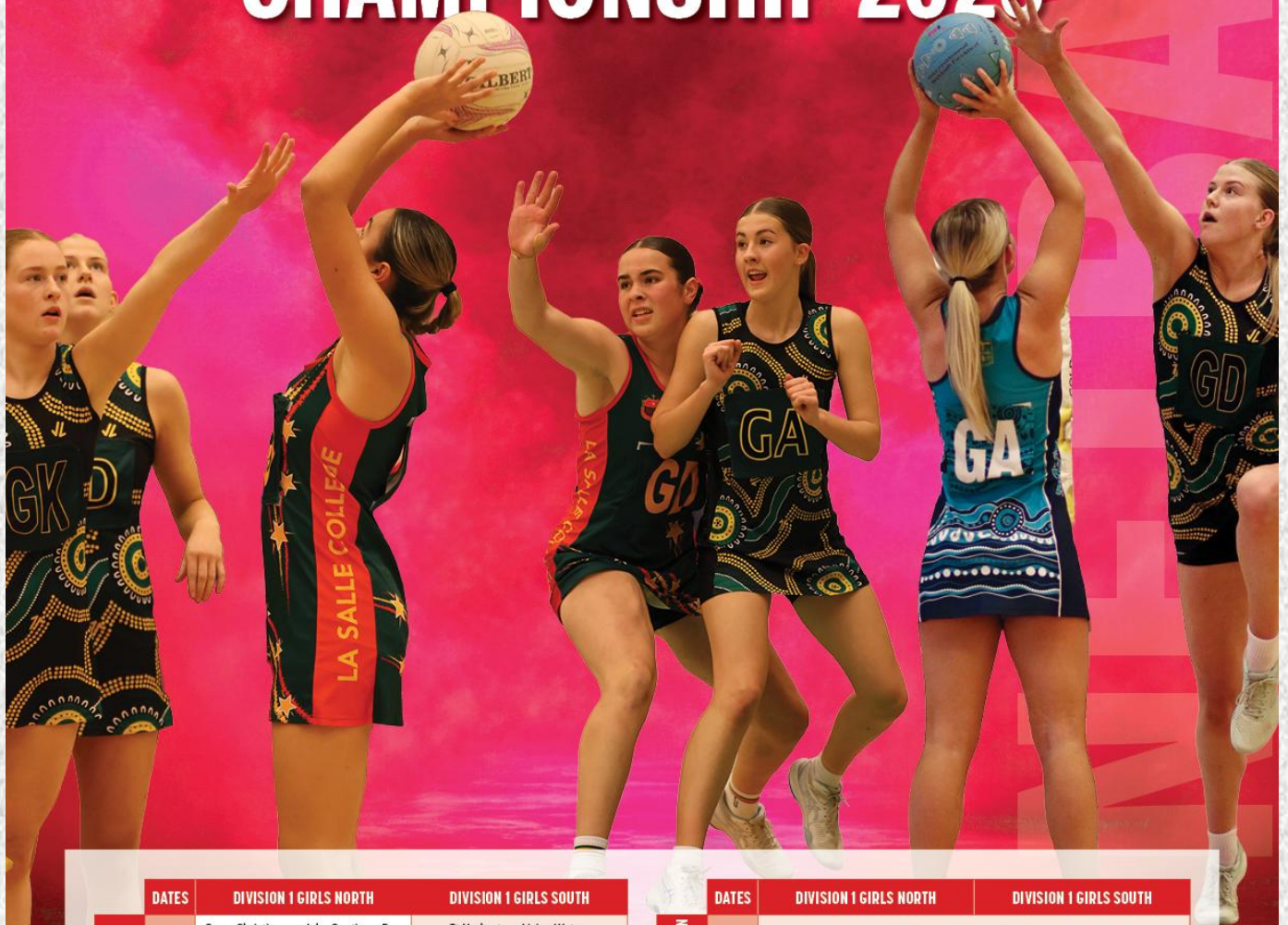

ACC DIVISIONAL NETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP 2026



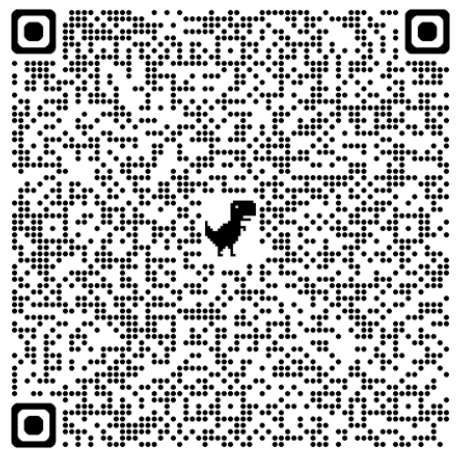
