1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Time:** 10.00am – 12.30pm *Schools are encouraged to arrive at 9.30am for school seating set-up and briefing*
- **Cost:** Costs for the day will be shared amongst participating schools. These costs will include Beach/Council Booking, Courtyard Hire and BBQ lunch.

2. NOMINATION OF STUDENTS

- Any student with a disability (years 7 to 12), whether enrolled in an Education Support unit or not, is eligible to attend.
- Beach Carnival nominations are to be received by the ACC office no later than *December 2017* No late nominations will be accepted.
- Nominations are to be submitted online via a web form on the ACC website by completing the required information:
 - Student names
 - Year Group

- Once Nomination is complete an EXCEL copy of your students should be sent through to the Inclusion Officer to confirm names, year groups and any particular grouping of students that staff wish.

- Contact the ACC office if you have any problems with the nomination form.
- Students will be grouped as close to age-groups as possible. Please inform the Inclusion Officer if you wish to have students specifically grouped together.
- Wheelchair participants: The ACC are endeavouring to have activities specifically for wheelchair participants that coincide with the beach activities.

3. SUPERVISION

- Schools nominating students must make arrangements for adequate supervision.
- Schools are to provide 1:10 Staff: Student Ratio (ACC General Recommendation)
- Schools are to supply 1 x Surf Rescue Qualified Staff Member who will not be responsible for own schools Supervision. But assist in the Supervision of all students with other qualified staff.
- **Sorrento Surf Lifesaving Club:** Full Time Lifeguards-on Beach, Volunteer Surf Patrol for Water, Surf Rescue Equipment, IRB and First Aid Room availability
- **Host/Duty School:** Students are to arrive early for Set up of Marquees on Beach, Flags, Activity area and markings and Ironman Area. Duty school students are to remain behind at end to clear beach area and pack away all equipment for the Sorrento Surf Club
- School supervising staff are required to assist with students needs throughout the day.

4. FIRST AID

- Sorrento Surf Club have a fully equipped First Aid Room available for use including Beach equipment with Full Time Life guard on Beach.
- However it is also the schools responsibility to bring any specific First Aid students under their care may require for the day.
- Students receiving First Aid care from facility staff **must** be under the supervision of a staff member that their relevant case history and specific needs are communicated to the facility staff.

5. SPECTATORS

- Spectators are to be supervised by staff at all times and are encouraged to participate in the BEACH CARNIVAL AND ALL ACTIVITIES at their own risk.
- Marquees provide by Sorrento Surf Club will be made available. However, schools can bring their own to ensure adequate covered area for their students.

6. SHADE/SHELTER/PROTECTION

- Marquees provide by Sorrento Surf Club will be made available. However, schools can bring their own to ensure adequate covered area for their students.
- In the event that the forecast for the day is inclement weather, the ACC will SMS all IS school representatives and advise accordingly by 8.30am on the morning of the carnival.

7. FORMAT OF THE DAY

- The schools will meet on location no later than 9.30am to set up their school base under marquees and/or erect any shade or shelter provisions.
- At 9.45am the ACC Sports Administrator and Inclusion Officer will formally welcome and address all schools in attendance and usher the participants to the starting line for the Ironman Events. On the hooter, the IRONMAN will commence and all participants will endeavour to swim/wade and paddle 2 x laps of the designated marked out area in water and on land
- Winning Male and Female Ironman Competitors will receive a Certificate. Staff are required to assist all students in the water for the duration of this event
- Land and Water Based activities will commence at 10.20-12.30am. The groups will rotate every 20 minutes.

- Schools attending will be responsible for providing at least one activity for the students to do and bring all appropriate equipment for the activity
- Pack up with the assistance from the Duty School will commence around 12.00pm
- BBQ Lunch (assisted by Sacred Heat Volunteers) will be held in the Sorrento Surf Club undercover area from 12.15pm
