1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Date:** Friday 13th November, 2020

2. NOMINATION OF STUDENTS

- Any student with a disability (years 7 to 12), whether enrolled in an Education Support unit or not, is eligible to attend.
- Students are also required to bring three mainstream students to participate in the Integrated format
- Integrated Cricket nominations are to be received by the ACC office no later than **Monday 19th October 2020** No late nominations will be accepted.
- Nominations are to be submitted to the ACC Inclusion **Please Note:** Any special grouping requests must be noted on the nomination form

3. SUPERVISION

- Schools nominating students must make arrangements for adequate supervision.
- School supervising staff are required to assist with students needs throughout the day.
- Ensure adequate number of staff are available to supervise all of your students in their school cricket team for the day..

4. FIRST AID

- Injuries are to be attended to by the individual school staff. Assistance is also available from the facility staff that have a first aid kit. The ACC will provide a sports trainer St John Ambulance at the event which will be an oncost for all participating schools.
- Students receiving First Aid care from facility staff **must** be under the supervision of a staff member that their relevant case history and specific needs are communicated to the facility staff.
- Sun protection is encouraged at all times

5. SPECTATORS

- Spectators are to be supervised by staff at all times

6. SHADE/SHELTER/PROTECTION

- All schools are encouraged to source their own provisions for shade/shelter/protection. In the event that the forecast for the day is inclement weather, the ACC will SMS all IS school representatives and advise accordingly by 8.30am on the morning of the carnival.
- Marquees are to be set-up by schools to use on day. Please bring your school marquee and tarpaulin for seating if required.
- NOTE: There is limited shelter at the venue and weather is expected to be hot this time of year.

7. FORMAT OF THE DAY

- The schools will meet on location no later than 9.15am to set up their school base and erect any shade or shelter provisions.
- At 9.20am the ACC Inclusion Officer and WACA representative will formally welcome and address all schools in attendance and usher the teams to their designated coaching area group.
- All teams will attend a short 30-minute coaching clinic conducted by the SEDA Cricket student directed at the skills of the modified cricket game-Rapid Fire.
- Round Robin games will commence via an air-horn sound until completed or after 25 minutes have been played
- All teams and carers will assemble back to their school position and break for morning tea and lunch according to the daily Cricket Carnival schedule. This will be provided prior to the day to all attending schools
- Games will play until completed via a Round Robin Format. Teams will play Semi Finals and two teams will play in the Grand Final
- NOTE: Assistance throughout the day will be from the WACA and SEDA Cricket Australia.
