1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Cost:** All costs incurred will be shared amongst participating schools
- **Partnership:** Inclusive Sports Days commenced in 2012 in partnership with Inclusion WA. State Sporting Associations attend with their sport educators promoting their sport in the Inclusion community.

2. NOMINATION OF STUDENTS

- Any student with a disability (years 7 to 12), whether enrolled in an Education Support unit or not, is eligible to attend.
- Sports Day nominations are to be received by the ACC office no later than **Monday 8th April and Monday 19th^h October** No late nominations will be accepted.
- Nominations are to be submitted online via a web form on the ACC website by completing the required information:
 - Student names
 - Year Group
 - Schools are welcome to bring mainstream students to assist with their students and the running of the activities. Please included these student's names on nomination form. Highlight if possible.

 - Student names **MUST** be included on the nomination form so that suitable provisions can be made. *Refer to Appendix 1*

3. SUPERVISION

- Schools nominating students must make arrangements for adequate supervision.
- School supervising staff are required to assist with students needs throughout the day.
- Ensure adequate number of staff are available to supervise all of your students in the various groups on the day.

4. FIRST AID

- Injuries are to be attended to by the individual school staff. Assistance is also available from the facility staff that have a first aid kit. The ACC will provide a sports trainer St John Ambulance at the event which will be an oncost for all participating schools.
- Students receiving First Aid care from facility staff **must** be under the supervision of a staff member that their relevant case history and specific needs are communicated to the facility staff.

5. SPECTATORS

- Spectators are to be supervised by staff at all times

6. SHADE/SHELTER/PROTECTION

- All schools are encouraged to source their own provisions for shade/shelter/protection. In the event that the forecast for the day is inclement weather, the ACC will SMS all IS school representatives and advise accordingly by 8.30am on the morning of the carnival.
- Marquees will be set-up in a small area for schools to use on the Sports Day 2 (John XXIII College) only. Please bring your school marquee for use on Sports Day 1 (Alderbury Reserve).

7. FORMAT OF THE DAY

- The schools will meet on location no later than 9.30am to set up their school base and erect any shade or shelter provisions.
- At 9.50am the ACC Sports Administrator will formally welcome and address all schools in attendance and usher the participants to their designated group. On the hooter, the SPORTS DAY will commence and all participants will continue with various activities throughout the day. Each activity will have a duration of 20-25 minutes.
- All participants and carers will assemble back to their school position and break for morning tea and lunch according to the daily Sports Day schedule. This will be provided prior to the day to all attending schools
- Activities will continue until 6 rounds have been completed
- NOTE: students wishing to participate in a certain activity that is not allocated to their group schedule, may do so at any stage. Staff however, are to keep in mind numbers of students in each group and ensure one group is not impacted by large changes on the day.
- Sports involved for the day MAY include: Netball, Soccer, Gymnastics, Touch Football, Cricket, Wheelchair Basketball, Basketball, Badminton, Ultimate Frisbee, Rowing, AFL, Fencing, Lawn Bowls, Softball, Volleyball, Hockey, Catch Music, Little Athletics
- State Sporting Associations with the assistance of their sport educators will facilitate each sport activity
- Students from SEDA, VET and attending schools may attend as volunteers for the day
