1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Time:** 11.00am-1.00pm ***Schools are encouraged to arrive at 10.45am for shoe distribution etc. Unless a specific arrival time is provided to you from the venue.*
NOTE: Morley has requested that you arrive to play at 11.30am-1.30pm due to a regular booking

• Warwick:	2 games: \$17.00 per student

• Cannington:	2 games \$14.00 per student	

- Charges are **payable to** Warwick Super Bowl, AMF Cannington or Morley Bowl by each school upon entry to the facility. **Please ensure you have an existing account or are paying cash on arrival.**
- School and student lane allocations will be organised before the day based on nominations.
- A maximum of 80 students at Warwick, 100 students at Cannington and 100 students at Morley can attend the bowling at each venue and nominations/places will be assigned on a first in basis.
- Schools can nominate students to play & pay for one game or two games, or a combination. Most years schools pay for **two** games, as reasonably able students will complete 1 game well within a 2 hour time frame and they should consider playing 2 games.
- Schools can select which venue they would like to attend. If a venue is full schools will be allocated to the other venue.
- Bowling lane bumpers and disabled ramps will be provided.
- Please phone Warwick/Cannington/Morley Super Bowl for further information about the venue **including food options and student requirements. Note: Each centre has varying Policy's in regard to consumption of foods.**

2. NOMINATION OF STUDENTS

- Any student with a disability (years 7 to 12), whether enrolled in an Education Support unit or not, is eligible to attend.
- TPB nominations are to be received by the ACC office no later than **Monday 19th February 2018 and Monday 29th October, 2018**. No late nominations will be accepted.
- Nominations are to be submitted online via a web form on the ACC website by completing the required information:
 - Venue to attend
 - Number of Games to be played
 - Student names
 - Year Group
 - Special Needs (needs ramp etc...)

3. SUPERVISION

- Schools nominating students must make arrangements for adequate supervision.
- At least one staff member per 5 students is required.
- School supervising staff are required to assist with bowling and scoring. Scoring is optional and at the discretion of staff supervisors.

4. FIRST AID

- Injuries are to be attended to by the individual school staff. Assistance is also available from the facility staff that have a first aid kit.
- Students receiving First Aid care from facility staff **must** be under the supervision of a staff member that their relevant case history and specific needs are communicated to the facility staff.

5. SPECTATORS

- Spectators are to be supervised by staff at all times and are to be kept well clear of the bowling lanes.

6. BOWLING LANE ALLOCATION

- Each student nominated by his or her school will be allocated to a particular bowling lane. Where possible students will bowl with and against students from other schools.

7. BOWLING GUIDE

A bowling scoring guide is available from the ACC or venues if required.
