ACC ONE DAY CARNIVAL RULES & PROCEDURES

The Associated and Catholic Colleges of WA (ACC) reserves the right to cancel, change or amend any or all parts of the event format leading up to, and on the day, including playing times and fixtures. The ACC endeavours to uphold the associations motto of "Sport in the Right Spirit" in all stages of planning and running of this competition.

FIELD SET-UP & PACK DOWN

The allocated set-up school is named at the top of each set of carnival fixtures. This school is to arrive one hour prior to the first round, bring markers for each field boundary and apply goal post pads to all posts. All schools are required to assist with the return of equipment.

EQUIPMENT

Most venues can provide goal post pads. The ACC will notify schools if they are required to bring a set.

EVENT BRIEFING

The event briefing will occur 30 minutes prior to the start of round 1 in a central location at all venues. Coaches/Managers, and field/goal umpires must attend this briefing.

START TIME

Central timing will be used at all venues and each round will start on time. Coaches are expected to have their teams briefed and in position before the starting siren.

FORMAT

All fixtures will include two halves with a 5 minute half time break. There is a 15 minute break between games for 5 team pools and a 20 minutes break for 4 team pools.

SQUAD NUMBERS

Divisions 1-3 = 18 players (cap of 6 x Yr 9; Boys Divisions 4-6 = 15 players (cap of 5 x Yr 9). Each team is permitted up to seven (7) interchange players. Numbers on field should always be even.

AGE OF PLAYERS

Teams are made up of year 10 students. Students in years 7, 8, 11 or 12 cannot participate. Year 9 students can be used to 'top up' team numbers (see "Squad Numbers" above).

UMPIRES

The WAFC will supply accredited field umpires. **Each school is to provide an appropriately attired goal umpire with white goal flags.** The goal umpire should be a senior student or adult, Players are NOT to be used as goal umpires.

ACC ONE DAY CARNIVAL RULES & PROCEDURES

FOOTBALLS

Each school must provide their own game and warm-up footballs on the day. The WAFC will provide game balls for the Division 1 carnivals. Size 4 leather footballs are to be used.

UNIFORMS

All players MUST wear the official school AFL football uniform including the same shorts, socks and jumper. Schools should check the carnival booklet for possible clashes with jumper colours of opposition teams and come prepared for this. No jewellery can be worn. Runners and water carriers must be wearing school PE shirt and shorts or approriate vest.

MOUTH GUARDS

Mouth guards are strongly recommended by the ACC for all players. Schools allowing players to play without mouth guards must take full responsibility for any injuries incurred.

SCORECARDS

Scorecards are provided for each game. Scorecards are to be checked by both team coaches at the completion of each fixture. It is assumed that scoring discrepancies are settled immediately at the conclusion of the game and that all results handed in to the ACC are final.

TOILETS

Toilets are available at all venues. Some venues will also have change rooms.

DRINKS/FOOD

Responsibility of each team. Drink fountains are available at all venues. Should drink containers require refilling, there are taps available at various locations (location given at event briefing). Some venues will provide a canteen for food and drink purchase. Schools will be notified of these venues.

WARM-UP

Teams are encouraged to arrive 30-45 minutes prior to the first round so there is time for players to warm-up.

FIRST AID

St John Ambulance will be available at the venue (organized by the ACC).

WEATHER

In case of wet weather, teams are encouraged to bring a small pop-up tent for general coverage around the football fields. There is adequate shelter around the club rooms at most venues.

ACC ONE DAY CARNIVAL RULES & PROCEDURES

START AND END OF GAME ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Both teams line up opposite to each other in the centre of the ground. Field umpires will proceed with a coin toss between captains of each team. At the completion of the game each team captain will call his team to give three cheers to the other team.

EVENT RULES

Rules are in accordance with AFL Laws of Australian Football. A full version of the rules for this age group is available on the ACC website at www.accsport.asn.au/carnivals/afl-carnivals/rules-and-conditions-play.

POINTS & RESULTS

2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. Carnival fixtures, results and ladders are available via the Jaro/ACCWA mobile app.

POST-GAME

Presentations and acknowledgements will commence immediately following the final round of fixtures. All players, coaches and umpires are asked to make their way to the designated area as soon as possible.

COMPETITION STRUCTURE

After each year's competition, schools will be elevated or relegated from their allocated division depending on their place at the end of each carnival. The following protocols apply to this process:

- The first placed school in each division will be elevated to the higher division, e.g. winner of division 3 will be elevated to division 2. etc.
- The fifth placed school in each division will be relegated to the lower division, e.g. fifth place for division 3 will be relegated to division 4, etc.

In the event that the South West carnival winning school withdraws from their place in the division 1 carnival, the division 2 winner has the option to play in this carnival in that same year. The following applies:

- If they choose to play and they place fifth in the carnival, they will be relegated to division 2 and will remain in that carnival division the following year, i.e. they lose their right to be elevated.
- If they place higher than fifth, they will remain in division 1.
- If they choose not to play, they will be elevated to division 1 in the following year.

The winner of the division 1 carnival will be presented with the perpetual trophy - Eagles Schoolboys Cup. All other divisions will be presented with a perpetual shield.

MATCH OPERATIONS

MATCH OPERATIONS

- Ground size 135m-185m (L) x 110m-155m (W)
- Football Size 4 leather footballs.
- Positions As per AFL laws of Australian Football.
- Out of Bounds Last Possession Rule
- 1. From a kick or handball, a free kick is to be awarded to the nearest opponent.
- 2. If a player runs the ball over the boundary line, a free kick is to be awarded to the nearest opponent.
- 3. If the ball is off hands or a player's body, a ball-up is to occur 10m in from the boundary line.
- 4. If there is any doubt as to whose free kick it is, a ball-up is to occur 10m in from the boundary line.
- Protected Area The protected area at this level is 5m.
- Order-off Rule To be applied as per the Red & Yellow card system.
- Tackling Tackling is permitted as per AFL Laws of the game.



COMPETITION ROLES

Field Umpires

- Umpires are to officiate at each match played under the control of the WAFC. All
 umpires must comply with the AFL Law of Australian Football, WAFC Junior and Youth
 Rules and Regulations and any competition variations adopted by the governing
 bodies.
- Should a field umpire not be available to officiate, at any match the opposing coaches or team officials may agree to appoint any person to act in that capacity.
- All field umpires shall be suitably attired for the match.
- The collection of umpire related match documents is at the discretion of the WAFC.
- Any officially appointed emergency umpire will have the same powers as the central umpires.

Boundary Umpires

 Boundary umpires are not required for any Year 10 matches as the Last Possession Rule will apply as per "Out of Bounds".

Goal Umpires

- Each competing team shall supply a goal umpre who should be of sufficient knowledge and competency to carry out all responsibilities of the position, as defined in the Laws of the Game.
- The goal umpire will wear the approved attire and have a minimum of two signaling flags.
- The goal umpire will be supplied with a scorecard.
- The goal umpire will keep a record of each team's score during the game and will compare scorecards at the end of each half.
- At the conclusion of the game, the goal umpire will hand scorecards to the ACC carnival manager.
- The goal umpire will endeavour to keep the area immediately behind the goal line clear of spectators and other obstructions.
- The goal umpire is not permitted to coach or encourage players.
