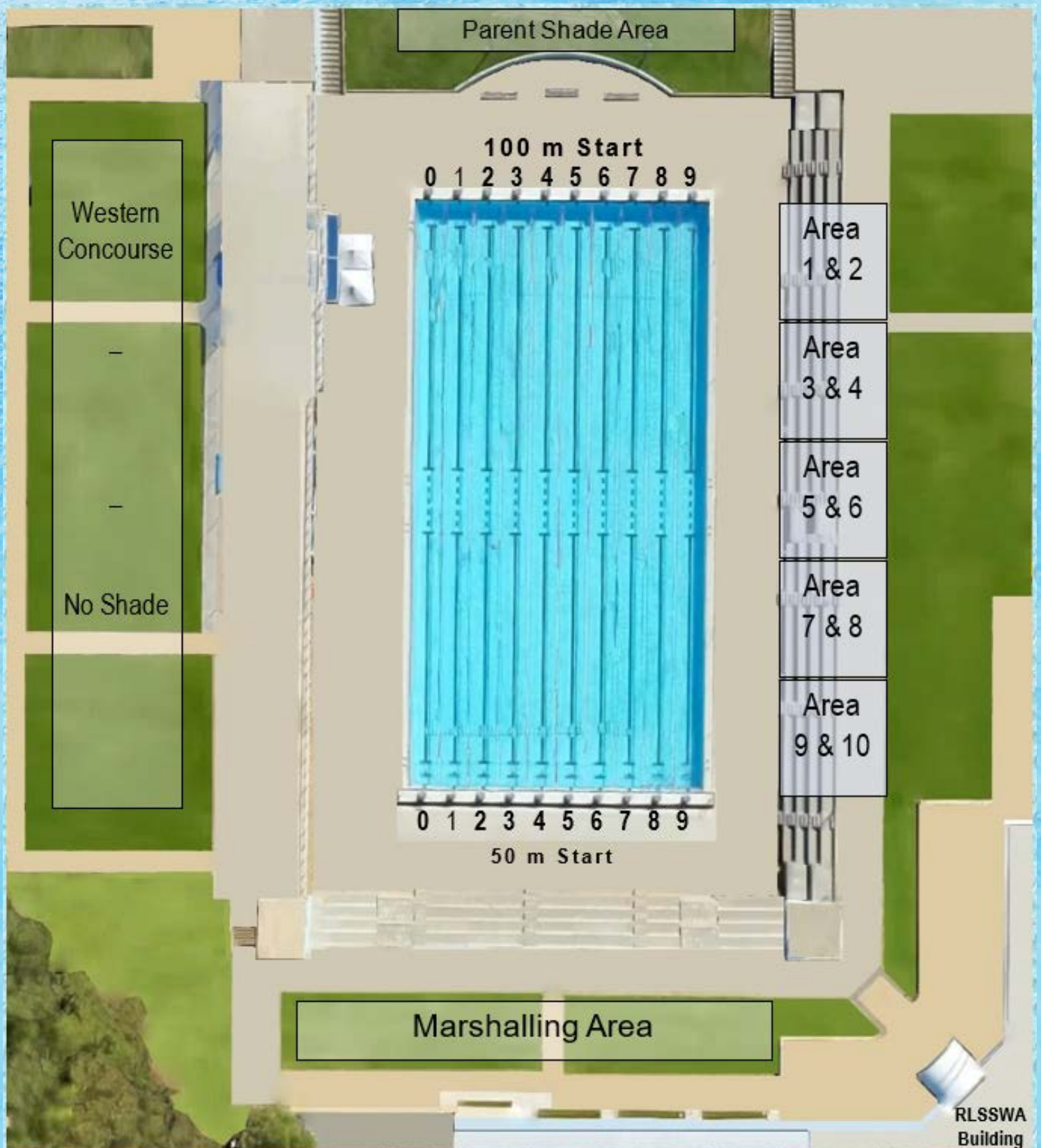

AGE CLASSIFICATION

- A, B, C and D Division – U13, U14, U15, U16, U17 and Open (U19)
- E and F Divisions – U13, U14, U15, U16 and Open (U19)
- G, H & I Divisions – U13, U14, U15 and Open (U19)
- J Division – U13, U14 and Open (U19)
- Junior categories include:
 - U13, U14 and U15 for A to F division carnivals
 - Only U13 and U14 for G, H, I and J division carnivals
- Senior categories include:
 - U16, U17 and Open (U19) for A, B, C and D division carnivals
 - Only U16 and Open (U19) for E and F division carnivals
 - Only U15 and Open (U19) for G, H and I division carnivals
 - Only Open (U19) for J division carnival
- All ACC carnivals will use one age cut-off date for age group classification.
The age cut-off date is 30 June for those born after 31 December 1996
- Competitors are permitted to compete in one age group only for all events.

TROPHIES

- A competitor who qualifies to compete in U14, but elects to compete in U15 for his or her FIRST EVENT must remain in U15 for all other events including relays.

Trophies are awarded in the following categories for all carnivals:

- Junior Boys and Junior Girls
- Senior Boys and Senior Girls
- Boys Overall Aggregate and Girls Overall Aggregate
- Combined Aggregate

AGE CHAMPIONS AND ALL STARS TEAM

The ACC does not announce age championship winners at the carnivals.

Championship winners will be posted on the web site after the carnival and will receive a certificate of acknowledgement. Following the series of carnivals, the ACC will compare all results and select an all stars team of the best performers in each event across all carnival divisions. Students selected in the all stars team will receive a certificate of acknowledgment and an all stars pin from the ACC.

EVENT RULES

- ACC swimming carnivals are conducted using Swimming WA officials under FINA rules, except if stated otherwise in the ACC Swim Charter.
- In 2015 the ACC adopted the FINA "one start" rule (SW 4.4).
- **The Start Rule:** Any swimmer starting before the starting signal shall be disqualified. If the starting signal sounds before the disqualification is declared, the race shall continue and the swimmer or swimmers shall be disqualified upon completion of the race. If the disqualification is declared before the starting signal, the signal shall not be given, but the remaining swimmers shall be called back and start again. The referee repeats the starting procedure beginning with the long whistle (the second one for backstroke).
- **Interpretation:** After all swimmers are "stationery" (SW 4.1), any swimmer who moves before the starting signal may be disqualified when such movement is observed and confirmed by both the starter and referee.
- **ACC Amendment:** Swimmers disqualified at the start shall still be allowed to swim in the race and the swimmer or swimmers shall be disqualified upon completion of the race. This change from FINA rules is to encourage participation and allow school aged competitors the opportunity to still compete in a race.
- **Use of video evidence:** In 2017 the ACC adopted the rule that there be no video recording to be used across all carnivals (swimming, athletics, cross country) as evidence for results or an appeal. Schools and parents may take video or photographic recordings of their own students, but this will not be used by the ACC as appeal evidence. The only use of video recording in result adjudication will be in cases where the ACC deem it appropriate for event officials to officially video record events for results purposes.
- **A & B Division:** To be conducted under FINA rules, except if stated otherwise above.
- **C-J Division:** To be conducted under FINA rules but modified with discretion and common sense. Swimming WA officials are to adjudicate on rule infringements and should only call a disqualification if the infringement provides the swimmer with a clear and unfair advantage, or causes disadvantage to another swimmer.
- Competitors must swim in their official school swimming cap and bathers. Competition racing bathers must meet FINA requirements.
- Competitors may swim in only one division of any event.
- In carnival divisions A-F, competitors may only swim in one individual Freestyle event - either 50m Freestyle or 100m Freestyle, but not both.
- Competitors in divisions G-J division carnivals may swim in both Freestyle events, i.e. a student that competes in the individual 100m Freestyle can also compete in the 50m Freestyle.

EVENT RULES

- For divisions G-J only, the 100m Freestyle and medley relay are unrestricted (UR) events. Swimmers from any age group may compete and still maintain their age group status, e.g. a swimmer competing in the U15 age category may also swim in the unrestricted 100m Freestyle and medley relay.
- Swim order for medley relay is Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Freestyle.
- In the event that variation in a placing occurs (e.g. malfunction in the electronic timing/judging or swimmer not touching the wall), the ratified result should be determined by the following method.
 - 1st Consideration:** Electronic timing based on the touchpad time.
 - 2nd Consideration:** The timekeepers in each lane based on the slower of the two times.
 - 3rd Consideration:** The Referee's decision, based on the manual place judge results.
 - Extra Consideration:** In the event of a touch pad or backup button failing to register a time (due to mechanism failure or touch pad not hit hard enough) the competitor will be given an adjusted time relevant to their correct place.

Post Carnival

The final determination of results will take place three days after the completion of the carnival. This stage of the scoring process represents the final outcome and in the event that points scores differ from those announced at the carnival, the schools involved will be notified. Trophies are then to be transferred using minimum process. The final point tallies will also be listed in the ACC's Yearbook.

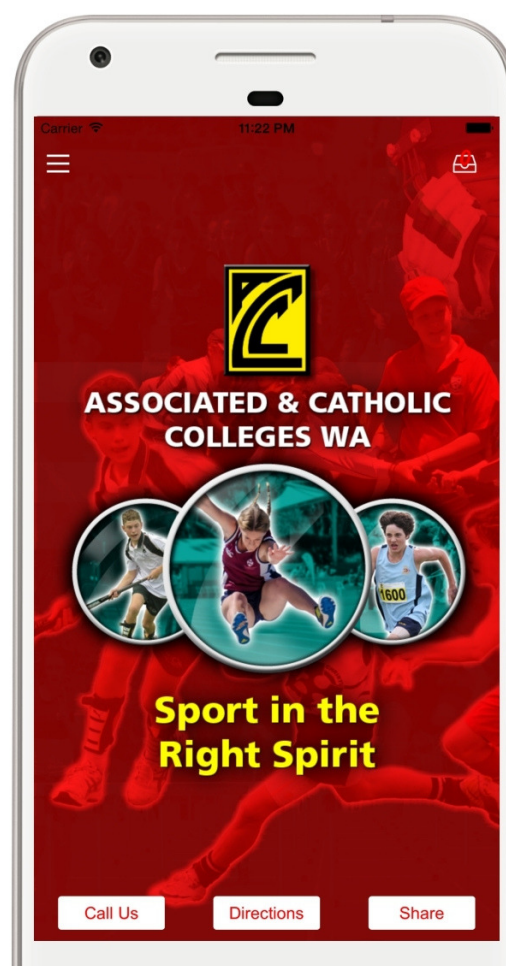

COVID-19 SAFETY PROCEDURES

All swimmers, staff/coaches, officials and other personnel are asked to follow the COVID-19 safety rules to keep everyone safe.

EQUIPMENT

- No sharing of personal items such as water bottles, towels, goggles or clothing is allowed.
- Shared equipment is to be cleaned by the school after use. Schools to provide own cleaning station.

CONTACT TRACING

- It is a requirement that contact tracing attendance records are maintained for patrons 16 years and over.
- School students (16 & over) and teachers will not be required to scan in/manually register contact details on entry. Schools will need to provide the venue a list of all students (16 & over) and teachers that are in attendance.
- Officials and spectators will be required to scan in/manually register contact details on entry to the venue.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Schools should maintain a strict limit of a minimum of 15 sqm separation between people who are not from the same household, school, or groups of other people.
- ACC will maintain 2 sqm per participant in swim competition areas, where practicable. In non-competition areas such as marshalling marquees, 15 sqm will be maintained, where practicable.
- Schools to carefully manage shared communal spaces to ensure physical distancing.
- Schools to manage entry/exit at the venue/transport to ensure physical distancing.

VENUE CAPACITY

- To comply with COVID restrictions there is a strict venue capacity for the indoor pool. Schools are required to comply with these restrictions as advised by Venues West.

GOOD HYGIENE

- Schools to provide hand sanitization stations for swimmers. Hands to be cleaned on arrival, after events and before departure.
- ACC to provide hand sanitization station for officials and other personnel.
- Schools to promote importance of personal hygiene to swimmers; hand cleaning, no physical greeting contact (i.e. hand shakes, high 5's, hugs, physical performance celebrations), no spitting, cough and sneeze covering.
- Venue to maintain frequent cleaning regimes of facilities and sitting areas after use.

IF YOU ARE FEELING UNWELL

- Players should report any flu or cold symptoms to their teacher if they are feeling unwell during the carnival. Sick swimmers can report to the first aid station for further assessment.
- Officials and other personnel should report any flu or cold symptoms to the ACC carnival manager if they are feeling unwell.
- People feeling unwell and showing flu/cold like symptoms will be isolated from other people and arrangements made for them to leave the venue ASAP. School staff and ACC to action their COVID-19 emergency response plan.
- The COVID-19 isolation area will be in the first aid room. There is a separate room for the indoor pool and the outdoor pool.
